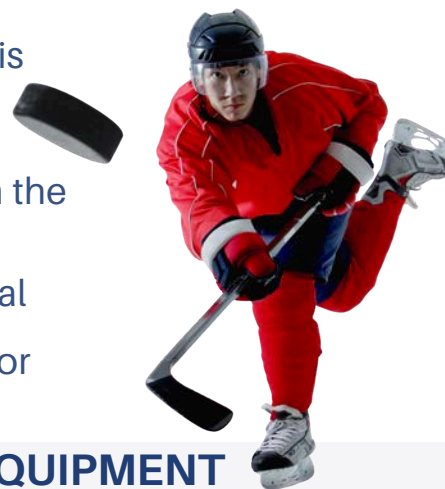




This is a true adult beginner hockey program - no prior experience is required.
